

ATTACK-CHAIN WORKSHEET



The Risk Deck runs on **any** lined-up attack chain. Before you start the Risk phase, fill the three things below from whatever source you are using. Each step must be concrete enough to argue a Likelihood and an Impact.

A GAME YOU PLAYED

The resolved kill chain from any game that sequences an attack.

A REAL INCIDENT

Something your team actually handled. Redact as needed.

A MITRE ATT&CK LINE

A sequence of techniques, ordered by tactic phase.

A VENDOR REPORT

A breach write-up or threat-intel narrative.

1 • ACTOR who is attacking, and how capable + motivated are they?

STRENGTH 1-5

2 • TARGET what are they after, and how much does it matter to the business?

IMPORTANCE 1-10

3 • THE CHAIN 3 to 4 ordered steps, from first access to the objective

WHAT THEY DID NEXT (PIVOT / ESCALATE)

HOW THEY PRESSED THE ADVANTAGE (C2 / SPREAD)

A vague step makes a vague brief. "They phished the finance team" beats "initial access." Name the system, the data, the move.
